WHAT ARE SOME KEY FEATURES OF THE WEBSITE AND MOBILE APP?

- The website and mobile app are available to the public 24/7 at no cost.
- Users are not required to set up an account to search for or to share resources on either the website or the mobile app.
- Users may search by program features, eligibility criteria, and geographical location.
- Users may print their search results or share them by email, text, or social media.
- Users may contact a resource directly through the website.
- Users may also suggest and submit resources.



WHAT RESOURCES ARE INCLUDED?

- Resources include a wide range of categories that reflect the full spectrum of what families with young children might need, including, but not limited to:
 - Early childhood programs
 - Housing
 - Recreation
 - Food
 - Medical and mental health
 - Safety



HOW WILL THESE RESOURCES AND THEIR CONTACT INFORMATION STAY CURRENT?

- Resources are verified and updated regularly by a curation team.
- Users can flag resources that require updates and the curation team will follow up.
- Each resource will list the date it was last updated.



WHAT DATA DO THE WEBSITE AND MOBILE APP COLLECT?

- The website and mobile app do not collect any personally identifiable information from users.
- The Office of Childhood will use information about the number of searches, categories of resources searched, and regions from which these searches originated to inform local early childhood plans and decision making.



HOW CAN THE WEBSITE AND MOBILE APP BE ACCESSED?

- Visit familyresources.mo.gov to access the website and links to download the mobile app on the App Store and Google Play.
